2022 In Review

In 2022 Reside Ga primarily focused on providing advocacy and referral services for individuals and families experiencing homelessness in Metropolitan Atlanta. In 2022 the Hotel to Home program that assisted individuals and families living in extended stay hotels was disbanded due to a dramatic decrease in contributions and donations. We were able to provide and maintain our other services with contributions from individuals.

DIRECT ASSITANCE PROGRAMS: Food, Temporary Shelter, Transportation, Hotel to Home

- The Food Assistance Program provided direct assistance for grocery and produce purchases.
- The Temporary Shelter Assistance Program assisted individuals and families residing at extended stay hotels by providing payment to the hotel when an eviction was pending.
- The Transportation Assistance Program provided assistance for transportation to a job, job interview, doctor's appointment or transportation to other organizations from which the client was seeking assistance.
- The Hotel to Home Program provided financial assistance to those clients accepted by the program to move from an extended stay hotel into an apartment.

CLIENT REFERRAL SERVICES

Referred clients to those resources that could better assist them with their current situation.

EXPENSES

The expenses incurred by the organization in 2022 were Program Expenses, Administrative Expenses, Nonprofit Donations, Salary & Wages, and IRS Fees and Registration. Program Expenses, which include all Direct Assistance Programs, accounted for 56% of total expenses for the organization, Administrative Expenses accounted for 30%, Nonprofit Donations accounted for 9%, Salary & Wages accounted for 4% and IRS Fees and Registration accounted for 1%.

REVENUE

100% of income received by the organization in 2022 came from individual contributions as there were no nonprofit donations to the organization in 2022.

2023 IMPACT

In 2023 Reside Ga will continue its commitment to improve the quality of life of those experiencing homelessness in Metropolitan Atlanta. Our primary focus for 2023 will be on advocacy and developing relationships with grassroots organizations that can help Reside Ga effectively advocate for those experiencing homelessness.
