2020 In Review

In 2020 Reside Ga provided direct assistance, referral services, and advocacy for individuals and families experiencing homelessness in Metropolitan Atlanta. We were able to provide these services through an employment internship program offered by disAbility Link, a non-profit agency that helps support people with disabilities by providing summer internships to college students or recent graduates. Three disAbility Link interns served with the organization for three months, allowing us to provide the following services and programs: Direct Assistance Programs, Client Referral Services and Advocacy Research.

DIRECT ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS: Food, Hygiene, Temporary Shelter, Transportation

- The Food Assistance Program provided direct assistance for grocery and produce purchases.
- The Hygiene Assistance Program provided direct assistance for the purchase of hygiene products.
- The Temporary Shelter Assistance Program assisted individuals and families residing at extended stay motels by providing payment to the motel when an eviction was pending.
- The Transportation Assistance Program provided assistance for transportation to a job, job interview, doctor's appointment or transportation to other organizations from which the client was seeking assistance.

CLIENT REFERRAL SERVICES

- Referred clients to the resources that could better assist them with their current situation.

ADVOCACY RESEARCH

- Research done to help nonprofit partners and community agencies be more effective in their communities and research done to assist nonprofit partners and community agencies in finding funding opportunities.

EXPENSES

The expenses incurred by the organization in 2020 were Program Expenses, Administrative Expenses and Fundraising Expenses. Program Expenses, which include all Direct Assistance Programs, accounted for 87% of total expenses for the organization, Administrative Expenses accounted for 12%, and Fundraising Expenses accounted for 1%.

REVENUE

Income received by the organization in 2020 came from individual contributions and contributions through fundraising. The organization received 94% percent of its income through individual contributions and 6% through contributions from fundraising.

In 2021 Reside will continue its commitment to improve the quality of life of those experiencing homelessness in Metropolitan Atlanta by helping them attain individual development, stability, and maintain family cohesion.
